4	Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY)	Rural poor youth under the age group 15-35 years, with relaxation of upto 45 years for women and people belonging to Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Group (PVTG), persons with physical disability, rehabilitated bonded labours, victims of Human trafficking, manual scavengers, transgender, HIV positive persons.
5	<b>National State Assistance Programme (NSAP) :</b> (i) Indira Gandhi National Old Age Pension Scheme (IGNOAPS). (ii) Indira Gandhi National Disable Pension Scheme (IGNDPS). (iii) Indira Gandhi National Widow Pension Scheme (IGNWPS). (iv) National Family Benefits Scheme (NFBS).	NSAP is primarily applicable to the BPL persons. However, poor and deserving people are also enrolled under the scheme based on filed verification even though their name does not figure out in the BPL List . IGNOAPS provides pension to persons attaining the age of 60 years and above. IGNWPS provides pension to widow between 40-79 years of age IGNDPS provides pension to person with severe or multiple disabilities between the age of 18-79 years of age. NFBS scheme provides a onetime financial assistance of Rs.20,000/- to a family on the death of a primary bread winner between the age of 18-59 years
